We will again have a booth on the green staffed by our Board of Directors and good friends from the Alfa Romeo Association. Please stop in to say hello.

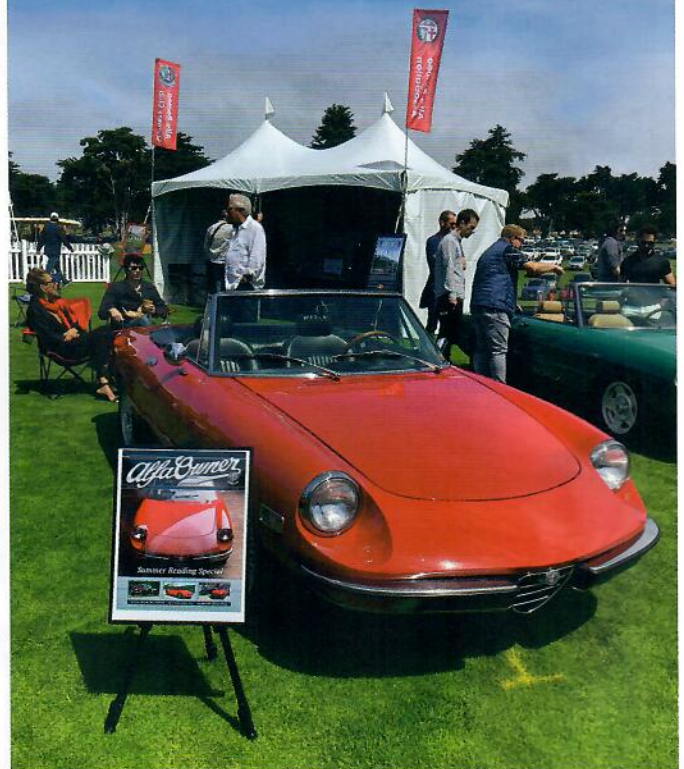
